Often children with eczema go into remission after a period of time. The remission may last the rest of their lives, although skin may remain sensitive and dry.¹

According to researchers at Purdue University, EFAs also increase production of collagen, a protein that makes up connective tissue and is a structural building block of firm, healthy skin. Because of the anti-inflammatory properties of Omega-"9" fatty acids, they are especially well-suited to treat eczema and possibly even psoriasis, both orally and topically.

An analysis of 26 clinical trials involving more than 1,200 eczema sufferers concluded that Omega -3, -6, and -9 oils have benefits for itching, crusting, inflammation, and redness of eczema, making it a safe alternative to topical steroids⁵

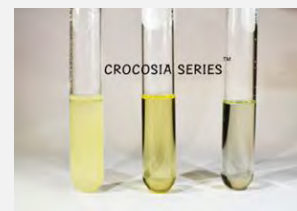
